A Message From Pastor Trent



As we reflect upon another year in the history of Foothills Church, it is with profound wonder and eager expectation that we celebrate the incredible work God has accomplished and continues to pursue through the body of FC. So much took place on our campus, in the lives of our partners and families, across our community, and around the globe. I truly believe 2018 was a year that signaled a transformative moment in the story of our church.

Together, we witnessed a wave of more than 1,600 first-time guests walking through our doors and a 22 percent increase in average weekly attendance. Furthermore, 164 people publicly professed their faith in Jesus through baptisms at FC.

In December, we cast a clear 2020 Vision for the next two years in the life of Foothills Church. That vision is bold and includes the opening of a second FC campus in the Bearden area of Knoxville. It also calls us to open a counseling center to serve the Blount County community, as well as witness 1,000 baptisms and 1,000 people complete Basecamp by 2020.

Early in 2018, we celebrated the opening of our new worship auditorium which symbolized a major step forward for our team and continues to serve the influx of people discovering our church.

I cannot express clearly enough or emphasize heavily enough just how unique this rapid growth and life-change across our church is. Yet, as we take a step back in awe at what we witnessed in 2018, we are reminded that we serve a God who works through miracles.

So as we march forward, firmly rooted in the founding vision of Foothills Church to develop mature disciples of Christ in relational environments, I pray that we as a church continue to experience the blessings God has poured out. And that the chapter of 2018 will be looked back upon as a stepping stone in an even grander story ahead.

FC OPENS NEW WORSHIP AUDITORIUM








REACHING OUR CITY WITH THE GOSPEL

In 2018, Foothills Church marched forward in its mission to develop mature disciples of Christ in relational environments and God responded in a big way. Average weekly attendance grew by 22 percent with 1,366 people walking through the doors of FC each Sunday. Additionally, a total of 1,627 first-time guests also discovered Foothills Church - a 47 percent increase in just one year. In a five-year period, since 2013, average weekly attendance at FC has grown by 178 percent.






DEVELOPING MATURE DISCIPLES OF CHRIST

At the core of Foothills Church, is the mission to develop mature disciples of Christ in relational environments. To carry out that mission, FC has developed The Journey, a four-part experience built to promote the mission of FC, help partners discover God's unique DESIGN for their life and get involved by promoting ministry leadership skills. With 195 people completing Basecamp, total partnership at FC rose to 734 - a 105 percent increase from the previous year.











EQUIPPING MINISTRY LEADERS OF TOMORROW

In 2018, Foothills Church officially launched The FC School of Ministry. With three unique tracks designed to provide in-depth teaching, the school is specifically designed to develop, train and equip ministry leaders. In its inaugural year, the FC School of Ministry welcomed 28 students. As part of the FC 2020 Vision, we aim to see more than 100 students complete the program in the next two years.







The FC Students ministry continued to grow at an exponential pace in 2018. The ministry saw a 94 percent increase in weekly attendance and more than 400 active students by the end of the year. 


