RESPONSIBILITIES

The SGP oversees the areas of small group development, guest services, and The School of Ministry.

- Small Groups — Oversee the development and execution of FC's vision to develop mature disciples of Christ in relational environments. The SGP will recruit, equip leaders, lead strategy to assimilate people into groups and engage in missional projects, and establish geographical based groups across the area.
- Guest Services— Oversee the Director of Hospitality to create a welcoming environment and memorable moments on Sundays that help new people connect to FC.
- School of Ministry— Oversea and assist the Lead Pastor to grow the FC School of Ministry.

EXPECTATIONS
